Started in 1981, Lutheran Counseling Network is a non-profit social ministry of the ELCA.

We have 15 offices, located in churches spanning from Bellingham to Federal Way and Enumclaw. Churches donate space, which allows us to provide a sliding scale based on household income.

We provide both teletherapy and in-person appointments.

In 2024, our ministry served a total of 7500 client hours. And 646 (8.61%) of those hours were subsidized by donations made by churches and individuals to our low-fee fund.

We are grateful for this shared vision for ministry, which allows us to bring grace for journeys of hope and healing.
